A Bill

To increase dialogue between the administration, students, and City of Williamsburg

Administration, College, and Town ACT

An Act of the 317th Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,

Sponsored by Senators Betty Jeanne Manning ('12), Jill Olszewski ('12), and Kim Green ('13)

WHEREAS, administrators shape College policy;

WHEREAS, city officials shape Williamsburg City Issues;

WHEREAS, student organizations shape Campus Life;

WHEREAS, increased dialogue is necessary to effect changes desired by the student body;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary –

1. Charges the sponsors of this bill with inviting guest speakers for each Senate session to increase the Student Assembly's accessibility and understanding of the Campus and City of Williamsburg.
2. Charges the sponsors of this bill with inviting the campus community and publicizing these Senate addresses.
3. Invites leaders of Student Organizations to deliver a five to ten minute address to the Senate on their view of the Campus community on the first and third Tuesdays of the month, while the second Tuesday of the month will be devoted to Administrators, and the fourth Tuesday to City Officials, followed by a question and answer session, not to last more than ten minutes.
4. Will chose speakers from a list of submissions garnered online through the SA website and Facebook group, and voted on in Outreach Committee.
