A Bill

To fund the renovation of electrical systems at the Daily Grind

The Daily Grind Renewal Act

An Act of the 317th Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Imad Matini (°11)

WHEREAS, The Daily Grind is frequented by undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty, and staff of the College;

WHEREAS, the owner of the Daily Grind, Scott Owen, regularly assists students outside of their need for a coffee fix;

WHEREAS, in recent years, increased customer flow has called for new equipment in The Daily Grind, leading to a need for higher electrical capacity;

WHEREAS, new equipment and higher usage has caused brownouts within the Grind, which could be easily fixed by upgrading the electrical panel of the building;

WHEREAS, upgrading the electrical panel would increase the power in the Daily Grind, allowing for the placement of more outlets, both inside and outside the building; and

WHEREAS, neither the school nor the owner have the capital needed to complete these upgrades;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary –

1. Allocates up to \$XXXX.XX from the Consolidated Reserve Fund to fund the upgrade to the electrical panel and the installment of more electrical outlets to be placed on the inside and outside of the Daily Grind; and
2. Charges the sponsor of this bill with obtaining an estimate for the total cost of the upgrades, and ensuring that the funds are only used for those upgrades within the Daily Grind.
